When I'm in Charge, Ages 8–11

This two-and-a-half-hour Red Cross course prepares children to respond safely to a variety of situations when direct parent supervision is unavailable. Participants will:

- * Role Play answering phone and door situations
- * Discuss gun and Internet safety
- * Discuss personal safety and first aid situations

Each student receives a participation guide, note pads and an emergency phone list blank. Parents are encouraged to attend the final half-hour of the class to watch the safety video and participate in the final class activity with their child(ren).
